## **INCIDENT TYPE – MAJOR SEIZURE SIGNIFICANT ARREST @ 1110 WINSLOW ST**

HIGH POINT, NC – On Saturday, January 26, 2019, at approximately 4:00 pm a High Point Police Officer stopped at 1110 Winslow St to investigate a suspicious vehicle parked in the driveway of the vacant residence. When the officer made his initial approach he discovered the vehicle was occupied by three (3) males.

As the officers began investigating they learned that the occupied vehicle (a 2006 Toyota Tacoma) had been reported stolen out of Randolph County. Officers also discovered that the registered owner of the vehicle was the victim of a breaking and entering in Randolph County which was being actively investigated by the sheriff's office.

Officers arrested all three occupants of the vehicle without incident and recovered numerous items of evidence, including but not limited to two rifles, one shotgun, one pistol, jewelry, knives, assorted tools, and United States currency. As a result of the investigation the following individuals were charged:

**Matthew King W/M 31 of Asheboro** was charged with the following felony offenses by the Randolph County Sheriff's Office: Safecracking, Breaking & Entering, Preparation to Commit Burglary, Larceny of a Firearm (3 counts), Larceny, Larceny After Breaking & Entering, and Possession of Stolen Goods. **King** was charged with the following by High Point Police: Felony Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance (2 counts), Misdemeanor Possession of Marijuana and Carrying a Concealed Gun (4 counts). **King** was confined to the Guilford County Jail (High Point) under a 1.2 million dollar secured bond.
