INCIDENT TYPE – ATTEMPTED ROBBERY AND ASSAULT INFLECTING SERIOUS INJURY (ARREST)

HIGH POINT, NC – On January 20, 2021, a Hispanic male came to the Police Department to report an Attempted Robbery and Aggravates Assault. The Hispanic male reported that while he was parked in front of 1507 Darden Street, two black males drug him from his car, hit him in the head with a handgun, and tried to take his wallet and money. The Hispanic male received a laceration to his head during the assault requiring staples. As a result of the investigation, warrants were obtained on **Indya Danielle Davis (B/F 18 of High Point)** for Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon and Assault Inflicting Serious Injury.

Davis was arrested on 02/16/21 and received a \$5,000 bond.

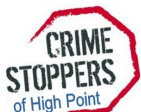
A second suspect has been identified as a 16-year-old juvenile male. Juvenile Petitions have been filed with Guilford County Courts.
