INCIDENT TYPE –TRAFFIC FATALITY

HIGH POINT, NC -

On Saturday October 9, 2021 at 11:28 P.M. Officers responded to Business I-85 near the I-74 interchange in reference to a reported pedestrian being stuck by a vehicle. When Officers arrived they located Charmaine Denise Bostick B/F 44 of High Point laying in the median. Preliminary investigation into this collision indicates that Mrs. Bostick had been driving north on Business I-85 with a companion. A verbal argument occurred in this vehicle between its occupants and Mrs. Bostick pulled her vehicle onto the north bound shoulder and parked. Mrs. Bostick exited her vehicle on foot and crossed the northbound lanes and median. She then began walking south in the southbound lanes of Business I-85. Another motorist traveling south struck Mrs. Bostick. Mrs. Bostick suffered life threatening injuries and despite lifesaving attempts by EMS and FIRE she died at the scene. There are no charges expected to be filed as a result of this collision. The driver of the vehicle that struck the victim did not sustain any injuries.
