INCIDENT TYPE – STOLEN MOTOR VEHICLE & FIREARM (ADDITIONAL CHARGES)

HIGH POINT, NC – On May 23, 2022, **Khasi L Gladden**; **B/M 20 of High Point** was charged with common law robbery and larceny of a motor vehicle. These charges are in reference to the carjacking at 2018 N. Centennial Street (*CR# 2022-13829*).

There is no additional information to release at this time.

INCIDENT TYPE – STOLEN MOTOR VEHICLE & FIREARM (ARREST)

HIGH POINT, NC – On Sunday, May 23, 2022, at approximately 12:30 am a High Point Police Officer observed a white 2018 Mercedes C300 that had previously been reported stolen by the Greensboro Police Department pass him headed eastbound while he was sitting stationary in the 2900blk of E Dr. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. This vehicle was taken in a carjacking in Greensboro on May 21, 2022, (*GPD CR# 20220521064*). The vehicle that had been stolen during the carjacking at 2108 N Centennial St (*CR# 2022-13829*) in High Point was used in the carjacking of this Mercedes in Greensboro.

Officers attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the stolen Mercedes but the driver refused to comply and a pursuit ensued and ended when the suspect crashed at Freeman Mill Rd & the I-40 ramp in Greensboro. The driver of the vehicle fled from the vehicle on foot after the crash leaving two passengers in the vehicle. A High Point Police K9 team responded to the area and located the suspect a short distance away where he was taken into custody without further incident.

As a result of this incident **Khasi L Gladden**; **B/M 20 of High Point** was charged with Felony Flee to Elude, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, 2 counts of First Degree Kidnapping, Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, Driving While License Revoked, and Reckless Driving. Gladden was confined to the Guilford County Jail (High Point) with no bond since he was on post-release. This was the fourth arrest of Gladden by the High Point Police Department since October 2018 involving a stolen motor vehicle or firearm.

All other incidents referenced above are still under investigation by local law enforcement and the facts of each case will be accessed to determine if probable cause exists to file additional charges.
