INCIDENT TYPE – ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON UPDATE

HIGH POINT, NC – Officers arrested four people, including three juveniles, in connection with a drive-by shooting. Two juveniles were injured in the shooting on Bridges Drive on October 31, 2022.

Officers arrested **Demont L. Williams Jr.** on November 8, 2022. The three juvenile suspects were arrested on November 14, 2022.

The suspect information and charges are listed below:

- **Demont L. Williams Jr. (B/M, 19 of High Point)** – Charged with two counts of assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury
- **Juvenile 1 (B/M, 17 of Greensboro)** - Charged with two counts of assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury
- **Juvenile 2 (B/M, 17 of High Point)** - Charged with two counts of assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury
- **Juvenile 3 (B/M, 17 of High Point)** - Charged with two counts of assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury

During the investigation, officers seized six guns, five of which are confirmed stolen. Officers also recovered six stolen vehicles.

Additional charges are expected for all four suspects.
