**INCIDENT TYPE – Robbery & Carjacking with Arrest**

HIGH POINT, NC - On Wednesday, October 11th, 2023, at around 10:46 PM, High Point police responded to a Robbery at an ATM and Carjacking at 1116 Eastchester Dr. The victim was approached by two males while he was taking cash out of the Cash Points ATM. Both suspects exited a black Mazda that was parked near the ATM and pointed pistols at the victim while demanding his money and his keys. The victim handed over the money he had just withdrawn from the ATM and the keys to his gray, 1994 Lexus 400. The two suspects then stole the victim's car and drove off, turning right onto Eastchester Dr. toward Wendover Av. The black Mazda that the suspects exited followed the stolen Lexus onto Eastchester Dr. Officers found the stolen Lexus at Wendover Av. and Gisbourne Dr., and a short pursuit ensued. The stolen Lexus had mechanical issues, and the suspects were unable to keep it on the road causing them to crash on Wendover Av. near Riverbend Rd. The driver of the stolen vehicle, Nolan Abrams (B/M, 23), was pulled from the vehicle and arrested. He was charged with Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon, Larceny of a Motor Vehicle, Felony Conspiracy, Assault by Pointing a Gun, and Felony Flee to Elude. The passenger, Xavier Hibbler (B/M, 23), who fled from the scene on foot, was located by a police K9 Officer during a track. Mr. Hibbler still had the stolen money on his person when he was arrested. Mr. Hibbler had an obvious injury to his knee, due to the vehicle crash, and was treated and then released from the ER. Mr. Hibbler was charged with Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon, Larceny of a Motor Vehicle, Felony Conspiracy, and Assault by Pointing a Gun. Both weapons used in the robbery were recovered with the car. Both subjects received No Bond for their charges and were placed in the High Point Jail. The third suspect who was operating the black Mazda remains at large. This investigation is ongoing.

The High Point Police Department remains committed to crime-fighting, community engagement, training, and professional policing. We will continue to collaborate with our community members and crime-fighting partners to promote a higher quality of life.
