INCIDENT TYPE – ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON (WITH ARREST)

HIGH POINT, NC – On Monday, October 16, 2017, at approximately 12:12 PM, High Point Communications received multiple calls indicating shots had been fired inside the Intown Suites, located at 2860 North Main St. The first responding officers arrived on scene at approximately 12:14 PM and came in contact with the two men believed to be involved in the incident. Both were detained by responding officers without incident. The call was originally dispatched as an active shooter and because of this designation responding High Point Police and Fire Personnel took extra measures to secure the scene and make sure there were no additional suspects or victims anywhere on the premises.

One of the men involved in the incident (a 26-year-old male) was struck (3) three times by gunfire and suffered non-life threatening wounds to the arm, upper chest and lower back. He was transported to Baptist Hospital for medical treatment. Kim J Davis Jr (B/M 25 of High Point) has been arrested and charged with Attempted Murder and Assault With a Deadly Weapon with Intent To Kill Inflicting Serious Injuries. There is no information on bond and court information at this time.

According to preliminary information, it appears the shooting resulted from an argument involving the suspect and the victim that escalated. Detectives seized multiple items of evidence from inside the hotel including, but not limited to, two (2) firearms.

Police detectives are continuing to investigate this incident and will evaluate if additional charges are appropriate. The High Point Police Department would like to thank High Point Fire, High Point Park Rangers and the staff of Intown Suites for their assistance during this investigation.
